

The SOCIAL SECURITY BOYS

The Social Security Boys present a new dimension in the realm of Gospel Music. The vocal style of this trio offers a rich and full blend of harmonies throughout a diverse repertoire which includes a variety of original material and Southern Gospel standards. They organized in August 2005 and began recording immediately. Shortly after the release of the album in February 2006, The Solid Gospel Network, which originates in Nashville, Tennessee, began to broadcast the title song "More Alive" across the country. In June 2006, Capitol Enterprises, a radio promoting corporation located in Savannah, Georgia, released the same song and continues to regularly release additional singles to over eleven hundred stations in the United States and foreign countries.

The group consists of lead singer/songwriter Vern Sullivan who has written such hits as "Rainbow Avenue", "Already Ready", "Healing", and "Shout It Out", baritone/lead vocalist James Austin and tenor Cecil Hinnant who are accomplished veterans of Southern Gospel music having sung with various groups most of their adult lives.

It is the desire of **The Social Security Boys** that Christians will find their concerts to be a time of spiritual renewal and that the message presented will point non-Christians directly to the cross.
